The ECTS system improves the flexibility of study programmes for students and allows credits obtained at one higher education institution to be computed towards a qualification studied at another, therefore representing learning based on defined learning outcomes and their associated workload.

The ECTS system is based on two main aspects:  
- Information (about study programmes and student achievements)  
- Mutual agreement (between partner institutions and the student)  
In this way, 60 ECTS credits are equivalent to a full academic year and 30 ECTS credits are equivalent to one academic term.
